Initial Filing Fee:

Court Costs: \$65.00 (If proof of Notices need to be filed, there will be an additional fee of \$1.00 per page).

Requirements:

A disinterment is filed in the Probate Court in the County in which the decedent is buried. The applicant must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.

To be filed when all waivers (and proofs of notices) have been completed

Note:

A hearing is necessary if you do not have signed Waivers from everyone who is entitled to Notice or there are other matters requiring clarification. If there is a hearing, then the applicant will submit a:

Notice of Hearing on Application for Disinterment (Form 25.2).

- The applicant will prepare one for each person not waiving notice. The Court will fill in both the hearing date and case number and mail them to applicant for service by certified mail. The applicant must file the US Postal Return Receipt with the Court.
- Proof of Service

Verification of Reinterment (Form 25.4)

Due for filing by the reinterment cemetery 30 days after the Order to Disinter.
