Initial Filing Fee:

Court Costs: \$225.00 Person or Person & Estate \$125.00 Estate

Requirements:

*The Court has no jurisdiction to accept a guardianship case for a minor until the child has lived in Ohio for at least 6 consecutive months immediately prior to the filing, unless the minor faces a medical emergency, has been abandoned (no contact or visits with a parent for at least 90 days), or the home state declines its jurisdiction in writing. In applicable cases, the proof of the exception to the 6 month residency requirement must be provided with the initial case filing.

Process:

Set a hearing approximately 5 weeks from the filing date.
