

CHECKLIST

MINOR'S CLAIMS AND FUNDS

Initial Filing Fee:

Court Costs: \$70.00

- *The Court will require an additional advance deposit of \$5.00 for each year remaining through the minors 18th birthday to cover the filing fee for the annual verifications.*

Requirements:

Filed in the Probate Court in the County where the minor is resident.

- If the funds passing to the minor exceed \$25,000, (in the case of a minor's claim settlement being the net proceeds), then an Application for Guardianship of Estate must also be filed.
- If the funds result from a claim settlement in which there has been a separate case filed to approve the settlement, and the net proceeds passing to the minor are between \$10,000 and \$25,000, then an Application to Dispense with Guardianship must be filed.
- If there is no claim settlement case and the sum passing to the minor does not exceed \$25,000 then an Application to Dispense with Guardianship is required.

Process:

Set a hearing approximately 5 weeks from the filing date.

 - *If a parent is deceased, you must provide a copy of the death certificate.*

Note:

- Proposed Entry Approving Settlement of Minor's claim (Form 22.2) needs to be submitted to the Court prior to hearing.
- Minor and applicant shall attend scheduled hearing.
